**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

**ALFALFA:** For control of alfalfa weevil larvae, spotted  
leafhopper and aphids.

**FIRST CUTTING:** Apply 2-3 quarts per acre as soon as alfalfa  
weevil larvae damage appears in the field. Early application is  
desired to control the alfalfa weevil larvae when they are small.  
Do not apply within 7 days of harvest. Do not apply after  
full bloom.

**STUBBLE SPRAYING:** In areas where alfalfa weevil larvae  
appears at cutting time. Remove the first cutting and apply  
2-3 quarts per acre to the stubble to control alfalfa weevil  
larvae and aphids.

**SECOND AND SUBSEQUENT CUTTINGS:** Apply 2 to 3  
quarts per acre to control alfalfa weevil larvae, leafhopper and  
aphids as these insects appear.
