



DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Dilutions Ratio: Dilute one gallon of this product with four gallons of petroleum distillate before use.

To Repel Horn Flies and Face Flies: Fill the backrubber and face-rubber applicator with diluted insecticide. Wait a few minutes so that the canvas parts become saturated with solution. Keep receptacle at top or bottom (depending on design of backrubber) filled with diluted solution. Take care to properly install back rubber according to manufacturer's recommendations. The applicator should be located where the livestock loaf or congregate so that they may have access to it at all times. Repeated applications will build up repellency in those areas of the animal treated with the insecticide repellent.

Back Rubber Concentrate is especially compounded for use in Back Rubbers.

When applying Face Fly Treatment manually on the faces of cattle, apply at the rate of 1.0 fl.oz. of diluted insecticide per animal, paying particular attention to the areas near the eyes and nostrils. Wipe on with a heavy cloth or sponge, or spray on with a sprayer that delivers coarse droplets. DO NOT spray directly into the animal's eyes. Treatment should be made daily while the cattle are stanchioned for morning milking to give protection from face flies. DO NOT spray entire animal with this spray.
