DIRECTIONS FOR USE

1. For premise disinfection in houses, schools and public buildings. To disinfect, clean and deodorize floors, walls, sinks, toilet seats and urinals, scrub or mop surface with a solution of 3¼ ounces of C.T. Disinfectant No. 2 to a gallon of water.
2. To clean, deodorize and disinfect garbage cans, first remove all waste and then scrub with a solution of 3¼ ounces of C.T. Disinfectant No. 2 to a gallon of water.

WARNING Keep out of Reach of Children and away from Domestic Animals
May be fatal if swallowed or absorbed through skin. May produce severe burns.

Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. If spilled on skin, wash with water. Avoid breathing of vapors of undiluted material. Avoid contamination of food.

If swallowed, give white of egg, mucilage, starch, paste as an antidote. Use one tablespoonful of mustard as an emetic.

Do not reuse empty drum. Return to drum reconditioner or destroy by perforating or crushing and burying in a safe place.
