Dear Mr. Corpus:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

Change the the statement of practical treatment to read as follows:

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Do not induce vomiting because of aspiration of pneumonia hazard.

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF ON SKIN
OR CLOTHING: Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Wash skin with soap and warm water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

Change the ingredient statement by replacing Isoparaffinic Petroleum Hydrocarbons with "INERT INGREDIENTS.....99.04%". Add this sub-statement. "Contains petroleum distillates"

1. Flies and Mosquitoes. Close doors and windows. Direct spray towards ceiling and fill entire room with fog. Keep room closed for 10 to 20 minutes. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Repeat treatment as frequently as required.

2. Cockroaches, Waterbugs, Silverfish. Thorough and repeated spraying of the infested area should be done, hitting as many of the insects as possible. Pay particular attention to spraying in cracks, crevices, baseboards and other hiding places.

3. Fleas Infesting Premises. Can be controlled quickly and effectively by spraying floors and cracks of the infested areas. Fleas lurk in carpets and upholstered furniture. Spray liberally in these areas as well as in baseboards, wall cracks and sleeping quarters of animals for direct contact with these pests.

4. Spiders. Spray directly into or on spider web with as wet a spray as possible. Also spray directly on all visible spiders with a wet spray.

For use in Meat Packing Plants, Bakeries, Food Processing Plants, Warehouses, Boxcars, Poultry Plants, Restaurants, Super Markets, Bottling Plants, milk handling areas of milk, cheese, and ice cream plants. Wherever food products are made, stored, shipped or handled. Recommended for use in Hotels, Motels, Institutions, Theaters, Hospitals, Transportation Facilities, Trains, Buses, Planes.

Super Brand Insecticide kills flies, mosquitoes, cockroaches, waterbugs, fleas, silverfish, and spiders that are contacted by the product.

May be used undiluted or can be diluted 1:1 with Oxford 7481, Special Base Carrier, and yield an AA grade fly spray. CS 72-54.

Noncorrosive and nondeleterious to equipment, machinery and utensils. Modern insect control requires regular treatment and good housekeeping.

NOTE: In hospitals, patients should be removed prior to treatment. Do not return patient to room until after ventilation.
