



An oil base solution for either indoor or outdoor application as a surface spray to provide residual deposits for the control of flying insects. The residues formed by the wet spray are effective against resting flies, gnats, wasps, and mosquitoes.

Material may also be used in spot treatments for the control of such crawling insect pests as ants, roaches, spiders, silverfish, crickets, carpet beetles and brown dog ticks.

INSTRUCTIONS

Remove children and animals from the area to be sprayed. Do not use in commercial food preparation areas or in edible products areas of food processing plants.

Adjust the machine to deliver coarse, wet particles. Direct the spray onto surface to be treated, wetting the surface, but without excessive run-off. For flies, mosquitoes, and gnats, spray resting areas, both indoors and outdoors, such as around windows and door frames, screens, or other areas where insects tend to congregate. For listed crawling insects, spray cracks, crevices and other places where insects hide or breed. For brown dog ticks, spray local infested areas such as animal sleeping quarters. Replace animal bedding with fresh material after spraying. For carpet beetles, spray infested parts of rug or carpet, both top and bottom and the infested sections of baseboards.
