ACTIVE INGREDIENTS:

Steam Distilled Pine Oil, 70.0%; Potassium Soap, 20.0%.

INERT INGREDIENTS 10.0%

DIRECTIONS

For premise disinfection such as floors, walls and tile, mop with a solution of 1 part Pine Oil Disinfectant to 99 parts of water (1¼ oz. per gallon). To use as a deodorant around dog houses, kennels, garbage cans, use one cup to a 10 quart bucket of water.

CAUTION

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Harmful if Swallowed

Avoid getting in eyes. In case of contact, wash with water immediately.

FIRST AID. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting, give raw egg white, milk, mucilage, gruel or cornstarch paste. Call a physician. If contact with eyes occurs flush with water for 15 minutes.

Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard.
