For premise disinfection such as floors, walls and tile, mop with a solution of 1 part OXFORD PINE OIL DISINFECTANT to 99 parts of water (1-1/4 ounce per gallon). To use as a deodorant around dog houses, kennels, garbage cans, use one cup to a 10 quart bucket of water.
