Your Resubmission Dated August 6, 1992

This is in response to your resubmission referred to above, of revised draft labeling for the subject product.

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the revisions indicated below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.

1. Include the statement of misuse, "It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling" immediately beneath the "Directions" heading.

2. Revise the "Environmental Hazards" section as follows: "This product is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, ponds or streams. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Do not discharge into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or public water ways, unless such action is in accordance with a NPDES permit."

3. Add the following headings: Container Disposal: "Completely empty bag into application equipment. Then dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or, if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke". Pesticide Disposal: "Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is violation of Federal Law. If these

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wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance."

4. Delete "Sodium metasilicate (anhydrous)" from the active ingredient statement. It should be included with inert ingredients.

5. Add the heading "Physical and Chemical Hazards" above the statements on the side panel.

DIRECTIONS

Pipeline Milkers, Milking Machines and Pipelines

1. Immediately after milking, flush entire system with warm water 110° F until the water runs clear.
2. Sanitize, circulate a concentration of **SANITERGENT MARK X** at the rate of 1 ounce per gallon of water (100 PPM) at 160° F for 20-30 minutes opening and draining all valves at this time. Hand brush all parts not coming in contact with the solution.
3. Twice each week circulate a solution of **STEROSOL MILKSTONE REMOVER** to remove milkstone and cut down the possibilities of a high bacteria count in milkstone formation. Follow directions for use on **STEROSOL MILKSTONE REMOVER** label.
4. Rinse with warm water at 110° F until the water runs out clear.
5. Before reuse, sanitize with a solution of **STERAZONE UDDER WASH AND SANITIZER**. Follow directions for use on the label of **STERAZONE UDDER WASH AND SANITIZER**. Do not rinse. Rinse with potable water prior to use.

All treated equipment or food contact surfaces must be rinsed with potable water prior to reuse.
