This is in response to your resubmission referred to above, of revised draft labeling for the subject product.

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the revisions indicated below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.

1. Include the statement of misuse, "It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling" immediately beneath the "Directions" heading.

2. Revise the "Environmental Hazards" section as follows: "This product is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, ponds or streams. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Do not discharge into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or public water ways, unless such action is in accordance with a NPDES permit."

3. Add the following headings: Container Disposal: "Completely empty bag into application equipment. Then dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or, if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke". Pesticide Disposal: "Co not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is violation of Federal Law. If these

#### Pipeline Milkers, Milking Machines and Pipelines

- 1. Immediately after milking, flush entire system with warm water 110° F until the water runs dear.
