### DIRECTIONS

Open container and pour one-half of the container into toilet bowl. Flush immediately and repeatedly until ROOT OUT is gone. Then add remainder of container and repeat procedure. This should be done when use of facilities is low.

ROOT OUT can also be used directly into septic tank drainfield. Add one container of product directly to the drainfield clean out plug or distribution box which is normally located between the septic tank and the absorption disposal field. Flush with water from hose for approximately five (5) minutes. This water will carry ROOT OUT to the point of root blockage.
