For use on floors, walls, sink tops, garbage pails, telephones, rooms, bed pans and operating rooms. Effective against Staphylococcus aureus, Salmonella choleraesuis and Pseudomonas aeruginosa. Also effective against pathogenic fungi, Trichophyton interdigitale.

When used for sanitization of food processing equipment and food contact items, limit active quaternary to 200 ppm. Rinse with potable water.

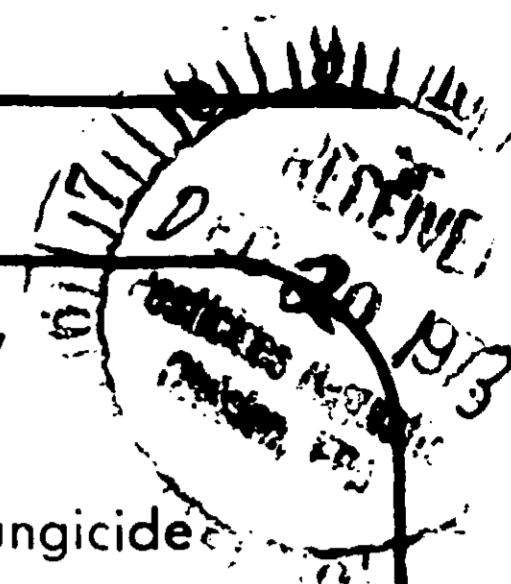
**DANGER**
