DIRECTIONS

ANTS: Spray ant trails, and hills, and surfaces where they are crawling. Pay particular attention to door sills and around window frames, and openings around pipes and behind baseboards. Spray directly on as many insects as possible. Repeat application as necessary.

BEDBUGS: Spray baseboards, moulding, floorboards, furniture under loose wall paper and any cracks where bedbugs may hide. Spray bed mattresses thoroughly, paying particular attention to seams and tufts. Dismantle and spray bed frames and springs, particularly cracks and joints. Repeat application when necessary.

FLEAS: Spray walls, floors, floor coverings and sleeping quarters of pets, and other infested areas, paying particular attention to cracks and crevices. CAUTION Do not spray animal pets.

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid direct spraying of foodstuffs, dishes or utensils. Do not use on humans, pets or plants.

Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

Do not use in edible products, areas of food processing plants, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed.

DURING APPLICATION: Keep spray in constant motion at least 36 inches away from walls, fabrics, furniture, floors, plastics, etc. as closer application may cause stains. Some asphalt tile, linoleum and plastic materials or water base paint may discolor or soften when wet with petroleum base insecticide. Test such materials in an inconspicuous area before spraying.

DIRECTIONS

Remove plastic cap. Hold can upright. Point spray opening away from you and press button. Apply sparingly in short bursts.

FOR SMALL FLYING INSECTS: — Flies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths and Gnats.

Close windows and doors. Direct spray towards ceiling in all areas until the room is filled with mist. Direct spray into corners, under furniture, in closets and areas where insects may hide. When spraying, keep sprayer about three feet from walls or furniture. Leave room closed for fifteen (15) minutes. Do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate the area after treatment is completed.

FOR CRAWLING INSECTS: —

Roaches (Waterbugs), Silverfish, Crickets and Spiders. Apply as a coarse spray directly on insects when possible. Also spray thoroughly in cracks and crevices, around baseboards, door sills, window frames, under and behind sinks, cupboards, drawers, woodwork, refrigerators, stoves, in storage areas, behind shelves, around pipes and drains and wherever these insects may hide and breed. Repeat applications when necessary.

CLOTHES, MOTHS AND CARPET

BEETLES: — For moths, clean closets and spray thoroughly, paying particular attention to cracks and crevices. Moth-tight chests and vaults should be sprayed before being filled with materials. Clean and brush woolen articles. Repeat application every 30 days. For carpet beetles, be sure that cracks in floors are thoroughly wet with a coarse spray. When infested, spray both sides of the carpet thoroughly. When spraying near fabrics, keep sprayer in constant motion and at least 36 inches away from fabric to avoid possible staining. Repeat application as required.
