Wormicide is unique in that it penetrates the wood rather than seals it. It carries its protective ingredients deep into the pores, thereby adding years to the life of the boat. This clear water white solution is especially formulated for application to both the exterior and interior of hulls to provide protection from teredos, worms and other marine borers. It should be applied prior to the finishing. Wormicide has no effect on the finish coat.

DIRECTIONS—EXTERIOR HULL. Apply a liberal coat with a brush to new wood, or old wood where all paint has been removed. Allow at least 1 hour drying time before painting.

INTERIOR HULL APPLICATION FOR PREVENTION OF DRY ROT. The solution should be reduced by the ratio of 3 parts mineral spirits to 1 part 9150 Wormicide before application. Then apply a liberal coat of the reduced solution and allow at least 1 hour drying time before painting.
