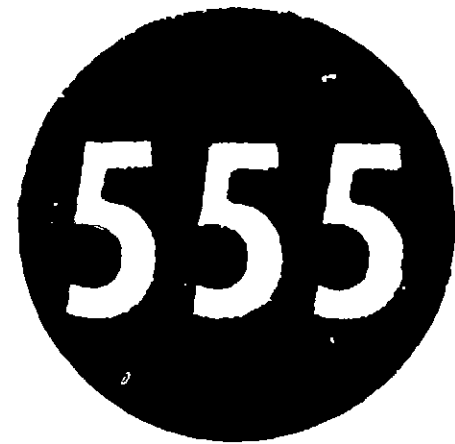

## Improved Pine Odor Disinfectant

### INGREDIENTS

#### ACTIVE INGREDIENTS

Isopropanol, Pine Oil, Soap,	
4 and 6-chloro-2-	
phenylphenol .....	31%

## DIRECTIONS

**TOILETS:** Use on toilets, urinals, shower stalls, tubs, sinks, walls and floors. Clean surfaces with a good soap or cleaner then mop with a solution of two ounces of disinfectant per gallon of water. Pour balance of solution into a commode and let stand for a fresh, clean odor in the bathroom.

**FLOORS:** Two ounces of this disinfectant to a gallon of scrub water and rinse water will provide a pleasant odor while the floor is being cleaned. The disinfectant in the rinse water also acts as a germicide.

**GENERAL DISINFECTION:** Kitchen tables, drainboards, sinks, refrigerators, and garbage cans should be rinsed thoroughly with a dilution of two ounces of this product to a gallon of water after being cleaned in the regular manner. Allow to stand in contact for five minutes.

### KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Avoid contact with the skin and eyes. In cases of contact wash at once with plenty of soap and water. Harmful if taken internally.
