

DIRECTIONS FOR USE It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To Clean - use four (4) tbsp. to one gallon of water for toilets, lavatory, tub, bathroom fixtures, kitchen cabinets and sinks. Apply with sponge or cloth.

To Disinfect - use six (a) thep. to one dallow of water on hard, inanimate, non-porous surraces such as floors, toilets, lavatories, tubs, tile, bathroom fixtures, kitchen countertors, diaper and garbage pails, sinks. Apply with mop, sponge, or cloth. Wet surfaces thoroughly, let stand 10 minutes, then rinse. For heavily soiled areas, a preliminary cleaning is required.

To Deodorize - use a few drops to deodorize toilet bowls. drops down the kitchen drain cuts grease, eliminates odors. Use 2 tbsp. to one quart water for garbage pails.

Laundry - add 1/2 cup to regular detergent to boost cleaning power for stubborn stains, grease spots, work clothes. Rub (exize Pine Oil full strength on stains, them wash as usual.

Dog Baths - use 3 tbsp. to 1 gallon of water. Removes odors.
