BOL-BRUTE

To disinfect and clean toilet bowls, first remove residual bowl water before pouring two (2) ounces of Bol-Brute into water remaining in cleaned bowl. Swab entire bowl thoroughly with solution. Flush toilet. For heavy deposits, pour approximately two (2) ounces of Bol-Brute directly on swab and clean surfaces. Flush toilet.

Hydrogen Chloride 11.02%
N-Alkyl (50%-C14, 40%-C12, 10%-C16)
dimethyl benzyl Ammonium Chloride 0.05%

DANGER: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.

EXTERNAL: Eyes - wash with water for 15 minutes. Get prompt medical attention. Skin - wipe off the acid gently, immediately flood with water, using soap freely, then cover with moist magnesia or baking soda.

Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.
