TO OPERATE:

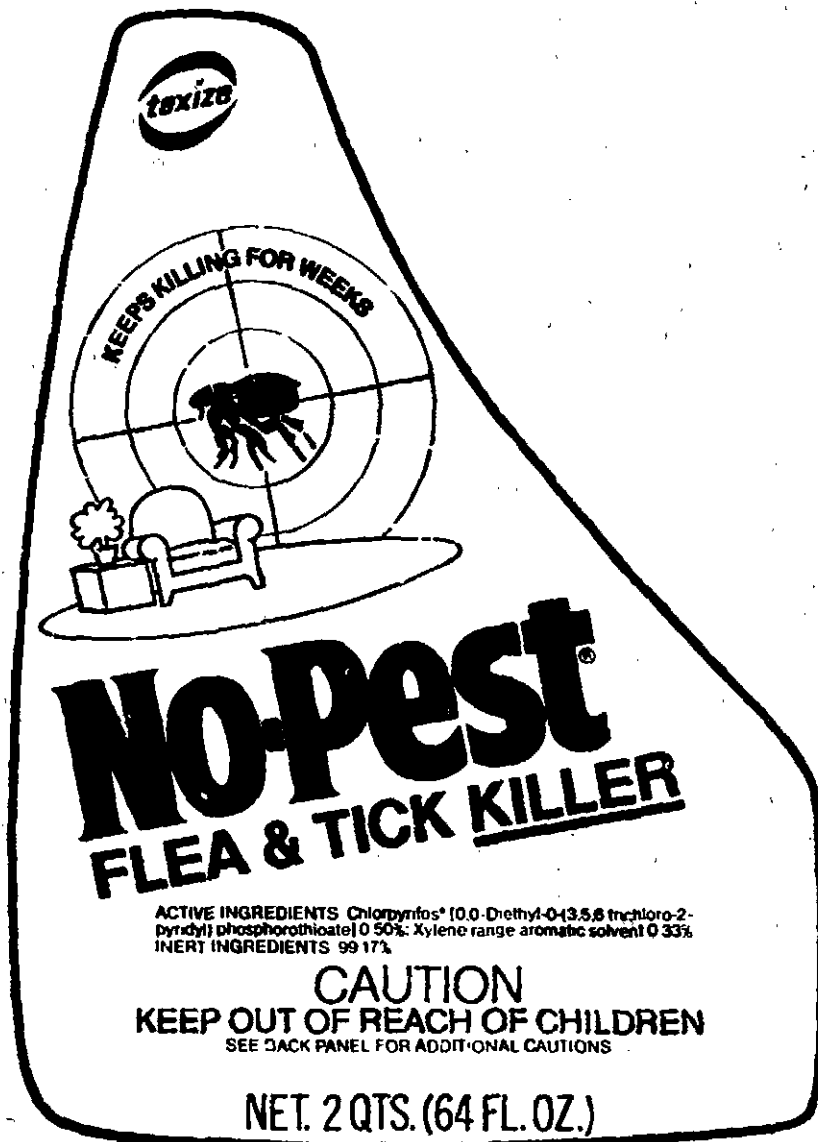
Do not spray in "off" position. Turn nozzle to "spray" or "stream" position before using. Nozzle should be 6-8 inches from surface being sprayed. Spray infested surface until wet. Repeat as necessary.

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TO KILL: PESTS OUT-OF-DOORS:

Flies and Mosquitoes: Use out-of-doors only as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of porches, patios, foundations, screens, window frames, eaves, garages and other areas where these pests congregate or have been seen.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame.
DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Empty container and put in trash collection.

SPRAYER OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS — 1. Remove red shipping cap and retain. Insert sprayer hose into bottle and tighten securely. 2. Prime sprayer by holding at cap level of bottle and pumping trigger. 3. To obtain jet stream, loosen nozzle tip two turns, tighten for fine mist. Nozzle should be 6-8 inches from surface being sprayed. Spray infested areas until wet. 4. **REMOVE SPRAYER AND REPLACE SHIPPING CAP BETWEEN USES TO PREVENT LEAKAGE, SPILLAGE OR EVAPORATION.** Spray water through sprayer after each use. Sprayer should be rinsed thoroughly and pumped empty for storage.

FLEAS & TICKS INDOORS: To Kill Fleas and Brown Dog Ticks: thoroughly apply as a spray for spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor covering where these pests may be present. Remove and destroy pets' old bedding. Spray with a fine mist pets sleeping quarters and local areas of the floor. Put fresh bedding in pet's quarters after spray has dried. Do not treat animals with this product. Treat dogs and cats with a registered flea and tick product before allowing them to reenter treated area.

Fleas are a common problem in houses with pets such as dogs or cats. Respray these same areas in 7-10 days to kill newly developed fleas which will hatch from eggs left in the carpet or on the pets. Infestation can last for months if proper and complete treatment is not used to control them.

For control of carpet beetles, thoroughly apply as a spray for spot treatment along baseboards and edges of carpeting, under carpeting, rugs and furniture, in closets and on shelving, and wherever else these insects are seen or suspected. **PESTS OUT-OF-DOORS:** To Kill Fleas, Brown Dog Ticks, Ants, Crickets, Earwigs: For treatment of localized infestations of these insects in outdoor areas where there are weeds or brushy non-crop areas, spray infested areas thoroughly. For ants, thoroughly wet hills and runways. Repeat applications as infestations warrant and as reinfestations occur.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARD TO HUMANS: CAUTION: Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist. Keep away from food, feedstuffs and domestic water supplies. Wash thoroughly after handling.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Chlorpyrifos is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine only by injection is an antidote.

PHYSICAL HAZARDS: Do Not Use or Store Near Heat or Open Flame. Do Not Store Below 32°F.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is toxic to fish, birds, and other wildlife. Keep out of lakes, streams, ponds, tidal marshes and estuaries. Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.
