
DIRECTIONS FOR APPLICATION

ANIMAL BUILDINGS AND HOMES: For the control of flies, gnats and adult mosquitoes in animal buildings (horse barns, dairy barns, calf barns, shelter sheds, stables, pig parlors, poultry houses and dog kennels) other farm buildings and homes, apply one strip per 1000 cubic feet of enclosed area.

MILK ROOMS: For the control of flies, gnats and adult mosquitoes in milk rooms and bulk milk storage rooms, suspend one strip per 1000 cubic feet of enclosed areas.
