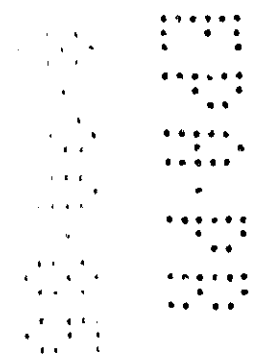

For Use on Washable Surfaces in Hospitals, Nursing Homes, Schools, and Other Institutions and Industries. Apply to walls, floors, and other hard (inanimate) non-porous surfaces such as tables, chairs, countertops, sinks, tile, porcelin and bedframes as a spray to thoroughly wet surfaces.

Effective against Pseudomonas aeruginosa, Staphylococcus aureus, Salmonella choleraesuis, Streptococcus fecalis, Tricophyton mentagrophytes (athlete's foot fungus). Also controls growth of mold and mildew.

Directions for Use

1. Fill a labelled Texize Easy® Sprayer bottle provided with product.
2. Turn tip to "spray" or "stream." Do not operate when "off" is in the top position.
3. To disinfect, spray surface until thoroughly wet. Let stand 10 minutes. Wipe clean with paper towel, clean cloth, or damp sponge. For heavily soiled areas, a preliminary cleaning is required.
4. To control fungi, spray surface until thoroughly wet. Wipe clean with paper towel, clean cloth, or damp sponge. Repeat application and allow to stand 10 minutes before wiping.
5. To control mildew, repeat weekly or when new growth appears.
