BEANS: For control of Mexican Bean Beetle, Bean Leaf Hopper, Spider Mites, Thrips and Aphids, apply at the rate of 30-35 pounds per acre. Begin applications early and continue every 7-10 days. For best results apply to underside of leaves. Do not apply to beans within 3 days of harvest.

CABBAGE: For control of Aphids and imported Cabbageworms, apply at the rate of 30-35 pounds per acre. Begin applications when aphids or worms first appear and continue every 7-10 days. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest.

CAUTION: Avoid breathing of dust. Avoid contact with skin. Wash thoroughly after using. Avoid contamination of feed and food-stuffs.

Remove harmful pesticidal residues at harvest from edible parts of growing food crops by washing, brushing or other means.
