Sevin Bean Dust is an insecticidal dust for use against certain insects attacking bean and potatoes.

DIRECTIONS

Use contrary to these directions may cause serious plant, crop or personal injury, excessive residues, unsatisfactory control or other unintended consequences.

BEANS-- Against Mexican Bean Beetle, dust thoroughly with 20 Lbs. per acre, every 7 to 10 days or as needed, beginning when insects first appear. Against Leafhoppers use 50-40 Lbs. per acre.

IRISH POTATOES-- Against Colorado Potato Beetle, dust thoroughly using 20 Lbs. per acre. Against Leafhoppers and Flea beetles use up to 30 Lbs. per acre. Dust when insects appear and repeat every 7 to 10 days or as needed.

NOTICE

The U. S. Food and Drug Administration has set tolerances for pesticide residues. Crops having residues in excess of their permitted tolerance should not be marketed and to do so may violate State law and will violate Federal law when sold in interstate commerce.
