

IMPORTANT! Before removing gloves, wash them with soap and water. Always wash hands, face and arms with soap and water before smoking, eating or drinking, ... AFTER WORK, take off all work clothes and shoes. Snower, using soap and water. Weer only creen clothes when leaving job. Do not wear contaminated clothing. Wash protective ciothing and protective equipment with some and water after each use. Compirator should be cleaned and filter replaced according to instructions included with respirator.

POISON SIGNS (Symptoms)

posed persons must receive prompt medical treatment or they may die. Some of the signs and symptoms of poisoning are: risadache, nausen, vomiting, cramps, weakness, blurred vision, pin-point pupils, tightness ir chest, labored breatning, nervousness, sweating, watering of eyes, drooling or frothing of mouth and nose, muscle spasms and coma.

FIRST AID TREATMENT

Call a doctor (physician), clinic or hospital immediately. Explain that the victim has been exposed to parathion and describe his condition.

If breathing has stopped, start artificial respiration immediately and maintain until doctor sees victim. If swallowed and victim is awake iconscious, make him yomit quickly. Induce vomiting by sticking finger down throat or by graing scapy or strong salty water to drink. Repeat until vomit is clear. Never give anything by mouth to an un conscious person. Have victim lie down and keep quiet. See doctor immediately. in case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes, while removing contaminated clothing and shoes. See doctor immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

Antidote administer atropine sulfate in large doses, TWO to FOUR mg. intravenously or Intramuscularly as soon as cyanosis is overcome. Repeat at 5 to 10 minute intervals untisigns of atropinization appear. 2 PAM chloride is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine, DO NOT GIVE MORPHINE OR TRANQUILIZERS Parathion is a strong cholinesterase inhibitor affecting the central and peripheral ner vous systems and producing cardiac and respiratory depression. At first sign of pulmonary edma. The patient should be given supplemental oxygen and treated symp tomatically. Continued absorption of the poison may occur and tatal relapses have been reported after initial improvement; VERY CLOSE SUPERVISION OF THE PATIENT IF INDICATED FOR AT LEAST 48 HOURS
