PRECAUTIONS IN USING

Do not apply or allow to drift to areas occupied by unprotected humans or beneficial animals. Vacated areas should not be re-entered until drifting insecticide and volatile residues have dissipated. Do not apply within 5 days of hand picking. Workers entering fields within 24 hrs. after application should wear protective clothing. Do not graze dairy animals or animals being finished for slaughter in treated fields.

Highly toxic to fish and wildlife. Do not contaminate any body of water nor apply to any areas not specified on the label. Do not contaminate food or feed products. To prevent re use, empty containers to be decontaminated and destroy. Keep container closed. Leaking containers should be removed to a safe place. Do not dispose of any unused material in such a manner that contact with humans or beneficial animals may occur.

GENERAL DIRECTIONS

ROYAL BRAND DU-MO can be used in conventional hydraulic sprayers, backpack sprayers, or similar devices. Use this product only in recommended proportions. Mix with water by agitation; agitate the mixture while spraying. If allowed to stand, re-agitate before use. Always mix with enough water for sufficient coverage.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

INSECT CONTROL ON COTTON — For control of aphids, Boll weevils, cotton leaf worm, flea-hoppers, and some species of spider mites: Use 1 3/4 pt. of DU-MO per acre. For control of Boll worm, and Budworm: use 1/3 gal. per acre. For timing of applications, consult your local extension service, or experiment station, and repeat applications as local conditions warrant.

DISPOSAL OF EMPTY CONTAINERS

DO NOT re-use the container. Completely empty the contents and bury the unused chemical at least 18 inches deep in an isolated location away from water supplies.

FIVE GALLON AND FIFTY-FIVE GALLON DRUMS—Pour the following mixtures into the empty containers:

5-GALLON DRUMS—2 qts. water, 1/2 cup caustic soda (household lye), 2 tablespoons detergent.

55-GALLON DRUMS—5 gallons water, 2 pounds caustic soda (household lye), 1 cup detergent.

Rotate container carefully until all inner surfaces are thoroughly wet. Bury the rinse solution at least 18 inches deep in an isolated area away from water supplies.

DO NOT use container in any connection with feed, food, or drinking water.

(CAUTION: Handle caustic soda (household lye) with extreme care. Do not get on skin, in eyes, or on clothing. Read and carefully follow the precautions on the package.)

Punch holes in the top and bottom of container, crush the container and bury deeply in an isolated area.

IF THE ABOVE RINSE METHOD CANNOT BE USED — Punch holes in the top of the container and burn in a hot fire until all of the paint has been completely burned off the container. Extreme caution should be exercised to insure that the containers are completely empty and that persons stay well away from the smoke and fumes.

Do not attempt to burn more than five containers at one time.

COMBUSTIBLE: Keep away from heat and open flames.
