

Poison: Antidote: If swallowed. Give a tablespoonful of salt in a glass of warm water and repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Have victim lie down and keep quiet. **CALL A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY.**

POISONOUS BY SKIN CONTACT

Poisonous if touched by hands or spilled or splashed on skin, in eyes or on clothing (liquid goes through clothes).

IF ON SKIN: If case of contact remove contaminated clothing. Immediately wash skin with soap and water.

POISONOUS IF BREATHED

Breathing vapors, spray mist or dust may be fatal.

POISONOUS TO FISH AND WILDLIFE

This product is toxic to fish and wildlife. Birds and other wildlife in treated areas may be killed. Keep out of any body of water. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from treated areas. Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment, or disposal of wastes.

CROP USE DIRECTIONS

Instructions below

LY WHEN WEARING THE FOLLOWING PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT AND CLOTHING

(1) water-proof pants, coat, hat, rubber boots or rubber overshoes. (2) Wear safety goggles. (3) Wear mask or respirator approved by the U. S. Bureau of Mines for paraffin protection. (4) Wear heavy duty natural rubber gloves.

WORK SAFETY RULES

unprotected persons and wash in away from treated area or where there is danger of drift. Rub eyes or mouth with hands. If you feel sick in any way, STOP work and get help right away. Call doctor, clinic or hospital immediately. Explain that the victim has been exposed to mirex and describe the condition. First aid is given in First Aid Treatment section and a medical examination is made at the clinic or hospital. Before leaving cover wash them with soap and water. Always wash your hands and arms well before smoking, eating or drinking.

WORK, take off all work clothes and shoes. Clean or change shirt and pants. Wear clean clothes. Do not wear contaminated clothing. Wash hands before eating or drinking. Wash hands after using the toilet. Keep hands clean. Avoid touching face.

POISON SIGNS & Symptoms

more dangerous than it really enters the body or enters the blood stream. It may be that the first symptom of tetanus is a slight spasm of the eyelid and eyelid. If it goes on, it can cause a spasm of the entire body, causing stiffness, cramps, and even convulsions. It can also cause muscle spasms and cramps.

FIRST AID TREATMENT

ctor (physician), decide to hospital immediately. Call 911 or go to nearest emergency room.

ing has stopped, start artificial respiration immediately and maintain until doctor arrives. If swallowed, an aware-conscious, make man vomit quickly with eanjutti by sticking fingers in nostrils. Give him salty water to drink. Repeat until vomit is clear. Then give him lime water in the recumbent position. Lie down and keep quiet. See doctor immediately. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with lime water for at least 15 minutes while removing contaminated clothing; and change clothes immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

administer atropine sulfate in large doses, TWO to FOUR mg intravenously or subcutaneously every 5 to 10 minutes. Do not exceed 10 mg. Repeat at 5 to 10 minute intervals until signs of atropinization appear. 2-PINCH technique is also effective and administered in conjunction with atropine. DO NOT GIVE MORPHINE OR TRANQUILIZERS. Pralidoxime is a cholinesterase inhibitor affecting the central and peripheral nervous systems and protecting brain and skeletal muscle. At first sign of pulmonary edema the patient should be given supplemental oxygen and treated symptomatically. Rapid absorption of the poison may occur and fatal delay has been reported after initial improvement. VERY close SUPERVISION OF PATIENT IS INDICATED FOR AT LEAST 48 HOURS.
