NURSERIES, CHRISTMAS TREE PLANTINGS AND SHELTER BELTS. Established Nursery Stock (see list below)

Broadcast 50-75 lbs. per acre in fall or spring to nursery stock established at least one year after transplanting. Apply prior to weed emergence. Controls many annual broadleaf and grass weeds such as: Annual bluegrass, annual ryegrass, common chickwood, crabgrass, lambsquarter and pigwood.

SHELTER BELTS AND CHRISTMAS TREE PLANTINGS (see list below)

Broadcast 50-100 lbs. per acre after transplanting and prior to weed emergence. For band applications reduce the rate of Simazine 4G in proportion to the area treated. For example: Apply 25-50 lbs. according to your soil type (Light sandy soil 25 lbs. per acre, medium loam 35 lbs. per acre and 50 lbs. per acre on heavy clay soils.) in a 4-foot band one mile long or ½ lbs per 1,000 sq. ft. Remove weed growth before application. Use the same rate for annual maintenance applications in established plantings.
