
FOR BUDWORMS: When mechanical hand dust applications are directed to the bud and top leaves only, apply 6 to 8 pounds per acre. Cloth bags and shaker cans are not acceptable for application of parathion, at any concentra-"ion. Do not apply within five days of priming or fifteen days of cutting. Avoid getting wet with plant juices

hen cutting the crop.
