GENERAL DIRECTIONS

Prepare a spray mixture of BEAN-TOX 82 as follows:

1. Add about half of the total amount of water to be used to the spray tank.
2. Start agitator or pump bypass and add proper amount of BEAN-TOX 82.

USE ONLY WHEN WEARING THE FOLLOWING PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT AND CLOTHING

- (1) Wear water-proof pants, coat, hat, rubber boots or rubber overshoes.
- (2) Wear safety goggles.
- (3) Wear mask or respirator approved by the U.S. Bureau of Mines for parathion protection.
- (4) Wear heavy duty, natural rubber gloves.

WORK SAFETY RULES

Keep all unprotected persons and children away from treated area or where there is danger of drift. Do not rub eyes or mouth with hands. If you feel sick in any way, STOP work and get help right away. Call a doctor (physician), clinic or hospital-immediately. Explain that the victim has been exposed to parathion and describe his condition. All first aid is given (see First Aid Treatment Section) and if a doctor cannot come take victim to clinic or hospital.

AFTER WORK, take off work clothes and shoes. Shower, using soap and water. Wear only clean clothes when leaving job. Do not wear contaminated clothing. Wash protective clothing and protective equipment with soap and water after each use. Respirator should be cleaned and later replaced according to instructions furnished with respirator.

POISON SIGNS (Symptoms)

Parathion is a powerful insecticide. It is highly toxic to humans. Symptoms of poisoning include: burning pain in the mouth and throat, drooping eyelids, blurred vision, difficulty swallowing, salivation, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, abdominal pain, muscle twitching, weakness, dizziness, headache, and loss of consciousness. Severe cases may result in convulsions, paralysis, and death.

FIRST AID TREATMENT

If you or someone else has been poisoned, get to a hospital immediately. Do not induce vomiting unless directed by a physician. If you have been splashed with the liquid, wash the affected area with plenty of water. If you have inhaled the mist, move to fresh air. If you have swallowed the liquid, do not eat or drink anything until you see a doctor. Do not use a stomach pump unless directed by a physician.
