DIRECTIONS FOR USE

FOR USE ON COTTON ONLY:

EQUIPMENT:

(a) Ground Equipment: Use conventional low volume spray equipment with sufficient nozzles and spray pressure to give the quate coverage. Use 4.05 to 5 pints per acre. Pump should have sufficient capacity to give good by-pass to keep spraymix agitated. Equipment should have a positive cot-off valve, to cut off boom. Equipment should be cleaned before changing products or going into new creps.

(b) Airplane Equipment, (Conventional Spray Equipment): Conventional aerial equipment may be used to apply this LV concentrate with the following suggestions and modifica-

HEIGHT -- 6' - 8' or crop height.

PUMPS --- Use primps capable of producing 40 to 50 p.s.i. A bleed line (1s to i, inch diameter) should be mitalled on the high point of the impeller chambers to release air that may be trapped in the chamber. The other end of this line should go into the spray tank.

NOZZLES - Use 15-30 nozzles with flat stray tipe for small aircraft such as Piper Pawnees or Swarmans, Spraying systems 8901, 80015 or 8002 with 100 mess weens are satisfactory. Nozzles the pointed down. Do not use full or hollow a mozzles. A large volume humesh screen should heard in the spray system.

FOR and NOZZLE PLACEMENT - Distance between the lest and right out-board nozzles should be approximately 3, of the wing span. An asymetrical nozzle arrangement may be needed at low altitudes. A 18 to 14 inch ble d line should be attached to both outer ends of the boom and routed back to the spray tark. This line will bleed off boom pressure and permit a sharp cutoff at end of swath.

BY-PASS - Use a by-pass system connecting the spray pump outlet with the pump inlet. This by-pass line must be equal in size to the pump outlet and should contain a valve controllable from the cockpit. The by-pass commonly used to circulate the posticide in the spray tank must be closed to avoid acrating the insecticide.

Early Season - For control of thrips, fleahoppers and plant bugs, apply one-third gallon of understed Cy-Fox ULV per acre. Make 2 to 3 applications at 7 day intervals starting at the two-leaf stage.

Mid and Late Season - To control bollworms, bollweevils and cotton leafworms, make repeat applications at 5 to 7 day intervals as counts indicate they are necessary. Apply Cy-Tox ULV at the rate of a sthird to ore-half gallon per acre,UNDILUTED
