IMPORTANT: Do not use Lindane in fields to be planted later in potatoes or other root crops, as it may adversely affect their flavor.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Do not contaminate food or feed by storage, disposal, or cleaning of equipment.

STORAGE

Feep this product in a tightly closed container when not in use. Store in ecol, dry, well ventilated area away from heat or open flame. In case of decomposition, isolate container (if possible) and flood area with large arounts of water to dissolve all material.
