**ANTIDOTE/FIRST AID**

**INTERNAL:** Give sodium chloride 15 gm. (one table spoon or table salt) in glass of warm water and repeat until vomitus clear.

**EXTERNAL:** Wash with soap and water.

**CALL PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY.**

**NOTE TO PHYSICIANS:** Malathion may cause hypotension and hypotonia. Atropine is antidotal. Toxaphene causes central nervous system excitation. It is similar to barbituric acid derivatives. Prevention of convulsions with barbiturates, preferably administered intravenously. If the barbiturate can be given before convulsions start, sodium phenobarbital is the drug of choice. Since toxaphene has a fairly long duration of action, a non-acting barbiturate such as phenobarbital may be used after initial control of convulsions. Refer to "Clinical Handbook on Economic Pesticides", which was prepared by the U. S. Department of Health, Education and Welfare, Public Health Service, Communicable Disease Center, Atlanta, Georgia.

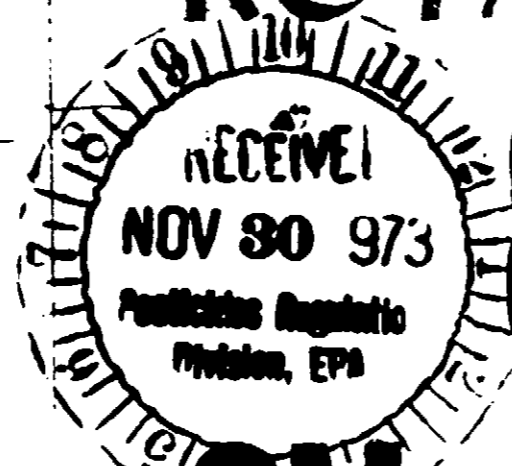

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE ON COTTON**

**EARLY SEASON:** For control of aphids, boll-weepvils, fleahoppers, plant bugs and thrips, apply 2 pints of 8-2 CY-TOX EC in sufficient water for coverage per acre by ground equipment or aircraft. Make 2 to 3 applications at 5 to 7 day intervals starting at two-leaf stage.

**MID and LATE SEASON:** To control aphids, boll-weepvils, bollworms and cotton leafworms, make repeat applications at 5 to 7 day intervals as counts indicate they are necessary. Apply 8-2 CY-TOX EC at a rate of 3 pints per acre by ground equipment or aircraft.

**USAGE WARNING**

Do not graze treated areas or feed treated forage to dairy animals or animals being finished for slaughter. Do not contaminate feed or feedstuffs. Use only as directed on label. Keep container tightly closed when not in use.
