DIRECTIONS FOR USE

This product is intended only for the control of brush and deciduous woody plants such as tree sprouts. It is not intended for use on growing crops but is for use on power line rights-of-way, stump land, and certain waste land areas where it is desired to kill or repress the growth of woody plants. Effective in the dosage indicated against the following shrubs and trees:

Ash	Maple
Aspen	Oak
Birch	Osage Orange
Blackberry	Poison Ivy

FOLIAGE TREATMENT (Late Spring Application): Use 1 to 2 quarts (½ to 1 lb. each of 2,4-D and 2,4,5-T) with sufficient water to adequately cover one acre. Apply early in the year when the new growth is succulent and rapidly growing. Repeat application in 4 to 6 weeks if needed. For application to smaller areas by hand or knapsack sprayers use ½ fluid oz. per gallon of water and apply at the rate of 1 gallon per sq. rod (272 sq. ft.)

BASAL BARK TREATMENT (Dormant or Growing Season Application): Use 1 pint (½ lbs. each of 2,4-D and 2,4,5-T) with 3 gals. of diesel oil or fuel oil and spray the basal part of the stem or trunk from the ground level to a height of 12 to 24 inches. Circle the trunk completely and spray until run-off occurs. Apply at any time of year, using a knapsack sprayer or low volume equipment.

STUMP TREATMENT (Dormant or Growing Season Application): Dilute 1 pint 2,4-D and 2,4,5-T with 3 gallons of diesel oil or fuel oil and apply with knapsack sprayer or low volume equipment. The bark as well as the cut surface should be wet thoroughly until run-off occurs. Treat freshly-cut stumps at any time, including winter months. Best results are usually obtained on stumps 1 inch across or larger. Repeat application if new growth develops.

DIRECTIONS

GRANULAR LAWN WEED KILLER is a convenient form of 2,4-D as low volatile ester for killing certain broad-leaved weeds in lawn and turf. Enters the plant through the leaves and works downward to roots, killing roots and all.

LAWN: To kill broad-leaved weeds such as dandelions, plantain and other di-cot (broad-leaved) weeds, apply 8 ounces per 212 square feet or 1 pound per 425 square feet of lawn area. Apply on a clear day to avoid wind drift. Make application very evenly by sprinkling on the ground with shaker can with no skips or misses. It is suggested that the area be covered twice (each coverage must be at half dose), the second time at right angles to the first to insure thorough coverage. Do not apply within three feet of shrubs, flowers, or other desirable plants. Repeat application in one month to control weeds that were skipped. If weeds are over 5 to 6 inches tall, they should be sprayed with Liquid Lawn Weed Killer. Do not use on St. Augustine grass, Bent grass, Dichondra, Carpetgrass or clover lawns. Note: Do not use on grass seedlings or newly seeded lawns. Use only on established grasses.
