DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Livestock Spray is a dual-purpose formulation designed to protect animals, including dairy and beef cattle, from the attacks of biting flies in the barn and on the pasture, as well as to function as an effective space spray for quick knock down and kill of houseflies in the barn and milkroom.

ANIMAL SPRAY: To protect animals against the attacks of horseflies, stable flies, horn flies, mosquitoes and gnats, apply just enough to wet the ends of the hanks but not enough to soak the hide. One to two ounces is sufficient to treat an adult cow. Apply once daily, preferable in the morning. Repeat at daily intervals or as necessary for continued protection.

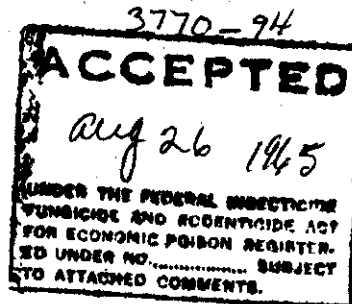
SPACE SPRAY: To attain quick knockdown and kill of flies, gnats, and mosquitoes in enclosed spaces, spray toward the ceiling and corners until the space is filled with a light mist. For best results, close all windows and doors prior to spraying and keep them closed for 10 to 15 minutes after spraying.

CAUTION

Do not overapply to animals. Protect milk and milking utensils from contamination by the spray. Do not store or spray near an open flame. Store in a cool place. Store out of reach of children. Keep container tightly closed. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs.
