

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

**GOPHERS** — With the aid of a long-handled spoon remove the soft earth plug leading underground at a freshly thrown-out mound of soil. Using the spoon, introduce the bait, 2-3 pellets per placement, as far down into the burrow as possible. Close the opening to the surface, being careful not to let loose dirt to cover the bait.

**MOLES** — If there are many runs the turf should first be rolled or leveled. If only a few runs are evident, press flat with the heel. Then as new runs appear insert a pointed stick into each run at about 4 foot intervals. Drop 2 or 3 pellets with a spoon into each hole and then close up the hole by pressing the turf together. Do not permit loose soil to cover the bait after placement.

**WARNING:** Convulsive poison! Poisonous if swallowed. Wash thoroughly after handling. Keep away from children or pets. Burn all pests killed. Do not contaminate feed or foodstuffs.

**ANTIDOTE:** If less than ten minutes has passed since the poison was taken, give emetic of tablespoonful of salt in a glass of warm water. Have victim lie down in a quiet, darkened room and keep him warm. **CALL A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY.**

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty containers. Destroy it by burying with waste or burning. Stay away from smoke or fumes.
