Apply in early spring before weed seeds germinate. Repeat at monthly intervals 2-3 times during growing season. For best results, follow these directions carefully:

- 1. Before applying, remove all existing broadleaf and grassy weeds since this product only kills sprouting seeds, not established weeds.
