FLEA and TICK SPRAY
PETS (cats, dogs, hamsters, mice and white rats)

Hold can upright and spray about 12 inches away from pet. Spray contents in circular motion for a more even coverage of coat. Continue spraying until tips of hair are moist. Work spray into skin of pet. Spray directly on ticks. For control of fleas on caged animals wash the cage completely and replace clean bedding in the cage. Use on bedding and treat the area around the cage as needed. Repeat treatments as necessary. Make a weekly check to see if treatment is necessary.

(additional caution to add to CAUTION statement)

Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

CAUTION: Do not spray in eyes of pet. In case of spraying in eyes, flush out with water.

Do not remain in treated areas and ventilate the area after treatment is completed.
