DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Seed Treatment — A special powder formulation for planter box treatment for temporarily protecting germinating seed and young seedlings from seed corn beetles, seed corn maggots, wireworm, white grubs and corn field ants.

Keep Planter Plates Clean: Grease or oil on plates can cause clogging.

Planter Box Application: Use on seed by mixing with the seed in the planter box. Sift directly on the seed in the planter box, or may be mixed in a rotating container such as a cement mixer. Best protection will be obtained where every seed is coated with the chemical.

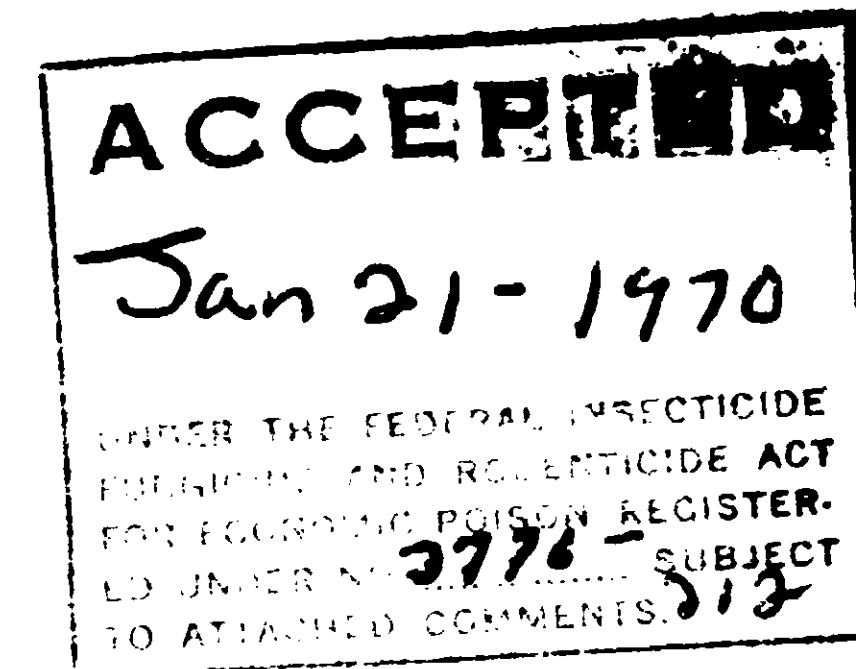
Rate of Application:

Seed Corn <i>seed treatment</i>	6 oz. per bushel of seed
Grain Milo	6 oz. per 100 lbs. of seed
Sorghum	6-8 oz. per 100 lbs. of seed
Soybeans	6-8 oz. per bushel
Wheat, Barley, Oats <i>seed</i>	4-6 oz. per 100 lbs.
Beans <i>seed</i>	3-4 oz. per bushel

Bags containing treated seed should bear a tag or label indicating thereon that the seed has been treated and should not be used for food, feed or oil purposes. Empty bags which contained treated seed should not be re-used for packing feed or food.

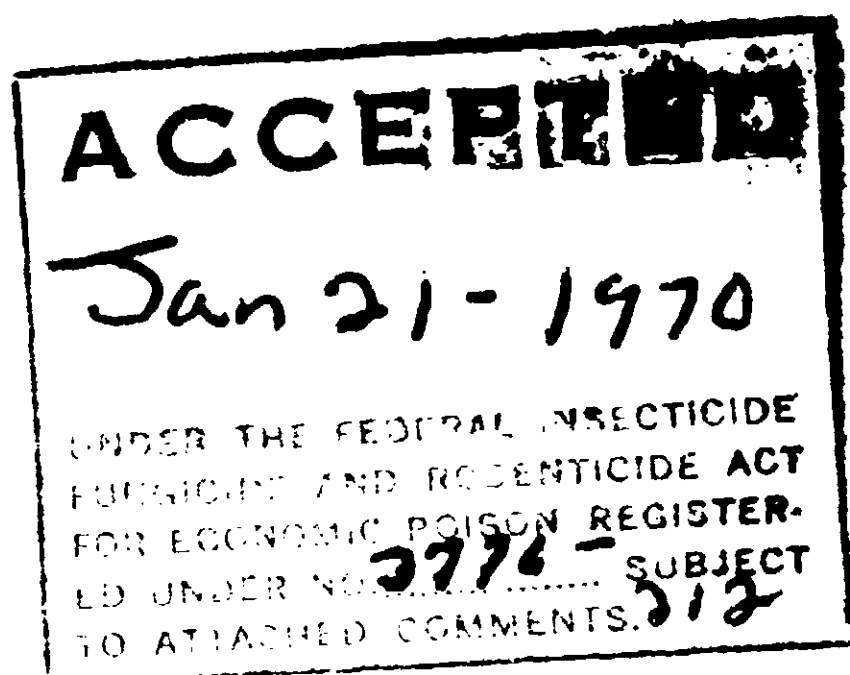
