### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Apply granules evenly over vegetables with proper spreading device. Treatments may be repeated as necessary. Dosages from one-half to one pound per 1000 sq. ft. will control cutworms, armyworms, crickets, darkling ground beetles, grasshoppers and sowbugs.

Beans, carrots, corn, eggplants, okra, peppers, potatoes, tomatoes and sweet corn	1 lb. 1000 sq. ft.	none
Corn	20 to 40 lbs. acre	none
Asparagus, strawberries	1 lb. 1000 sq. ft.	1 day
Broccoli, Brussels sprouts, cabbage, cauliflower, head lettuce, garden beets (roots), horse-radish, parsnips, radishes, rutabagas and turnips (roots)	1 lb. 1000 sq. ft.	3 days
Sugar beets, collards, endive (escarole), garden beets (tops), kale, leaf lettuce, parsley, spinach, Swiss chard and turnips (tops)	1 lb. 1000 sq. ft.	14 day
