A special powder formulation for planter box treatment of BEANS, CORN, PEAS, SOY-BEANS prior to planting, to aid in the protection of the germinating seeds and young seedlings against injury by seed corn beetles, seed corn maggots, wireworms, dampingoff, seed rots, seedling blights and fungus diseases of seeds and seedlings.

BEANS, CORN, PEAS, SOYDEANS — Planter Box Application: Use 3 ounces per bushel of seed in the planter box as a seed treatment prior to planting. Apply to seed as planter box is being filled. Mix thoroughly with seed in the planter box as follows — fill the planter box one-half full of seed then treat with one-half of desired amount of product. Mix well by stirring with a stick or paddle until color is imparted to seed. Add remaining seed to the planter box and cover with balance of product. Mix thoroughly again. Best protection will be obtained where every seed is coated with the chemical. Excess product flows with seed into the furrow giving additional protection against soil borne diseases.

Under some circumstances SEED PROTECTANT may affect the rate of seeding. It is necessary for the user to check planting rate frequently to assure himself that the desired planting rate is being obtained.

**Note: SEED PROTECTANT has been mixed with graphite as an aid in increasing the flowability of seeds and lubrication of equipment.
