DIRECTIONS

TOMATOES — Insects: Blister beetle, Colorado potato beetle, flea beetle, green peach aphid, cabbage looper, tomato fruitworm, yellow-striped armyworm, tomato hornworm, white fly, tomato russet mite. **Diseases:** Anthracnose, early and late blight, gray leaf spot (stem-phyllium), septoria leaf spot.

Foliar application: Dust lightly but uniformly to both leaf surfaces. Begin dusting at first signs of disease or insects and repeat application at 5- to 7-day intervals or oftener under late blight conditions.

Do not apply to tomatoes within 1 day of harvest.

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing of dust. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. In case of contact with skin or eyes flush with plenty of water; for eyes, get medical attention. Wash with soap and water after handling and before eating or smoking; wear clean clothing. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Do not apply to or allow to drift to areas occupied by unprotected humans or beneficial animals.

NOTE TO PHYSICIANS: Endosulfan is a central nervous system stimulant and may cause convulsions. There is no specific antidote. Barbituric acid derivative may be used in treatment.

ENVIRONMENTAL CAUTIONS: This product is toxic to fish and wildlife. Birds feeding on treated areas may be killed. Keep out of lakes, streams or ponds. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from areas treated. Do not apply where run-off is likely to occur. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment, or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

BEE CAUTION: This product is toxic to bees and should not be applied when bees are actively visiting the area.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Destroy it by burying with waste or burning. Stay away from smoke or fumes.

ROOT CROPS: Do not apply on tomatoes to be followed by root crops other than carrots, potatoes, or sweet potatoes.
