In the above letter, you submitted a revised A) label and B) Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF). Our review of these documents follows:

# A) Revised Label

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, provided you submit one (1) copy of final printed labeling to us before you ship your product.

If this condition is not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of this condition.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

# B. Revised CSF

The Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF), dated February 28, 1997, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable, provided the following changes are made:

1. On the first line of the CSF (i.e., Rotenone), in Block 13b under "22.6", add the nominal concentration as follows:

22.6 [1.67 nom.]

- 2. Change Block 14a from "23.0" to "1.72".
- 3. Change Block 14b from "22.4" to "1.62".

USE RESTRICTIONS: For control of non—woolly aphids (plant lice), flea beetles, sawfly larva and spittlebug on flowers, ornamental shrubs, trees and nonbearing fruit and nut trees. For control of non-woolly aphids (plant lice), bean leaf beetles, flea beetles, imported cabbage worm, sawfly larva, spittlebug, and aspargus beetle. on cabbage, cauliflower, lettuce, beans, tomatoes, peas, radishes, beets, onions, squash, cucumber, melons and aspargus. Will not injure tender plant foliage. May be used as a ready-to-use dust or as a wet spray.

# Mixing Directions:

Ready-to-Use-Dust: No mixing required.

Wet Spray: Stir or mix 3 to 4 tablespoonful amounts of dust into enough water to make a paste. Then add enough water to make 1 gallon of wet spray.

# Application Directions:

Begin application when plants are well established or when new growth appears.

Dust: When air is calm, sift directly from shaker top can or use a small hand duster.

Dust top and bottom of foliage and insects thoroughly...

Wet Spray: Using a small hand sprayer, apply to top and bottom of foliage to point of runoff.

### Retreatment Directions:

To prevent reinfestation, repeat application every 7 to 10 days, but sooner if heavy rains occur or if pests are present.

# ·HOME LAWNS

Use Restrictions: For control of night crawlers (also known as red or fish worms) in lawns where their mounds create a rough, uneven surface. This condition usually occurs during early, moist spring weather when night crawlers are most active near the surface. For quickest results, make application just before a spring shower when night crawlers come to the surface for feeding.

Application Directions: When air is calm, sift from shaker top can or use a small hand duster to apply dust at the rate of 1 pound per 250 sq. ft. Then water material into the ground.

#### PRE-TREATMENT DIRECTIONS

READ ENTIRE LABED BEFORE EACH USE

USE ONLY ON DOGS AND CATS TO RILL FLEAS, LICE, AND TICKS: Do not use on animals under 12 weeks.

#### SPECIAL ANIMALS

Consult a veterinarian or call this Animal Poison Control number 1-800-548-2423 before using this product on debilitated, aged, pregnant, nursing, or medicated animals.

### ADVERSE REACTION INFORMATION
