3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: USE INDOORS ONLY

Flying Insects: Flies, mosquitoes, small flying moths, wasps, gnats.

Calculate cubic feet of space to be treated. Close all doors and windows. Spray in a sweeping motion on all parts of the room. Apply for 2-3 seconds per 1000 cubic feet of space. Do not remain in treated areas. Vacate premises for at least 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate the area after treatment is completed and before re-entering. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. When using the product in these areas, apply only when facility is not in operation. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Repeat treatment as necessary.

Crawling Insects: Roaches, ants, spiders, silverfish.

Calculate square feet of floor to be treated. Open all cabinets, storage areas, closets. Spray directly on insects or in cracks and crevices, where insects hide.

For roaches: For best results, spray directly on roaches and thoroughly spray all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces, under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, food storage areas, and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. Also spray around door and window frames. Repeat as necessary.

For spiders and silverfish: For control of these insects, frequent and repeated spraying of baseboards, windows, door frames, bookcases, and storage areas should be made. For adequate control, spray directly on insects.

For crickets: Spray thoroughly and frequently behind stoves, refrigerators, under sinks, in food storage areas, and especially in closets, basements, and other dark areas. For best results, spray directly on insects.

For ants: Spray ant trails, nests and points of entry.

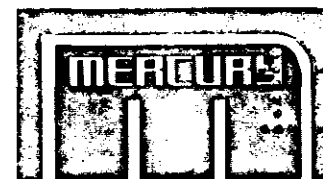
