DIRECTIONS FOR USE

TO CLEAN, AND SANITIZE WALLS, FLOORS, TABLES, REFRIGERATORS, STOVES, SINKS, BATHROOM FIXTURES, FOOD UTENSILS AND GARBAGE CANS: wash with solution containing one-half ounce Hi-Co per gallon of water. To disinfect, apply fresh solution after cleaning.

TO CLEAN, DISINFECT AND DEODORIZE WALLS, FLOORS, TABLES, REFRIGERATORS, STOVES, SINKS, BATHROOM FIXTURES, FOOD UTENSILS AND GARBAGE CANS: wash with solution containing one ounce of Hi-Co per gallon of water after cleaning.

TO DISINFECT SHEETS, LINENS, APRONS, UNIFORM AND OTHER FABRICS: soak in solution containing one ounce Hi-Co per gallon of water.

To deodorize particularly disagreeable odors use a solution of 3 ounces Hi-Co per gallon of water.

To control mold, wash with a solution of 2 ounces Hi-Co per gallon of water.

This detergent product will leave no soap scum and is excellent for use on conductive flooring.
