DISINFECTION

Pine Odor Lucide is a highly effective disinfectant against *Salmonella choleraesuis*, *Staphylococcus aureus* and *Streptococcus pyogenes*. These micro-organisms represent typical Gram-Positive and Gram-Negative strains. For general disinfecting, one part of Pine Odor Lucide should be diluted in 100 parts of water, or approximately one and one quarter ounce in 1 gallon water. This concentration should be employed for disinfecting heavily contaminated non-porous hard surfaces such as floors, walls, tables and other similar surfaces. All surfaces should be precleaned before disinfecting.
