The proposed amendment to the registration of the product cited above changing the declaration of petroleum distillates from active to inert and updating the label is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

1. Delete the phrase, "General Classification."
2. Add a physical and chemical hazard heading and the statement, "Do not use or store near heat or open flame" to the label.

These changes should be made at the next printing.

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS:** Direct the spray toward the upper portions of the enclosure and fill the atmosphere with mist, using 2 to 3 ounces of the product to each 1,000 cubic feet of space. If possible, keep the doors and windows closed for 10 minutes after applying the spray.

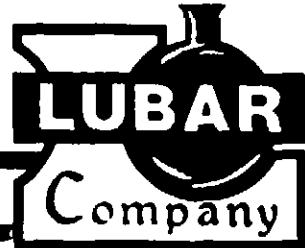
**Crawling Insects (Exposed to Accessible Stages):**

**ROACHES, SILVERFISH, SPIDERS:** Spray infested areas thoroughly and direct the liquid behind baseboards, moldings, cabinets, shelves, sinks, door and window frames and pipes, toward drains and dark corners, and into cracks, crevices, recesses and similar hiding places. Repeat as needed.

**ANTS:** Treat shelves, cabinets and storage areas. Spray ant runs, trails, baseboards, thresholds and other places of entry, and treat nests liberally.

**FLEAS, TICKS:** Direct the spray toward lower wall portions, baseboards, rugs, carpets and floors of infested areas. Spray animal quarters, kennels and the bedding of pets and other domestic animals.
