DIRECTIONS

TOILET BOWLS

1. Pour water from bowl with scrub mop.
2. Press water out of mop.
3. Apply 1 to 2 oz. of Bowl Cleaner to scrub mop.
4. Clean bowl - particularly under rim.
5. Flush toilet and use mop.

URINALS

1. Remove strainer.
2. Saturate mop with Bowl Cleaner.
3. Clean all urinal surfaces including sides and grooves.
4. Replace strainer. Flush urinal several times.

NOTE - Do not use on marble, waxed wood, or any surface except a heavy toilet seat. Do not use on other surfaces during application.

Do not empty container through drain. Seal and discard.
