The following amendment submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable with conditions listed below:

- Update label per PR Notice 2001-1

Conditions

Revise the label as follows:

1. According to records on file, this product is substantially similar to EPA Reg. No. 6836-108. The following "Precautionary Statement" changes must be made:

Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield, rubber gloves, and protective clothing. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

Please Note: The Agency is working with "Master" labels in which you are required to submit a label that includes all the possible directions, storage/disposal, and environmental hazards statements that would apply to your product regardless of the container size. The following 2 comments are in reference to this style of labeling.

2. According to the Application For Pesticide, Form 8570-1, this product is sold in containers ranging from 1 qt. to 55 gallons. For containers greater than 5 gallons, the Environmental Hazards statements must be placed on the label according to PR Notice 95-1.


Environmental Hazards: Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance, contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.

- 3. Since this product is sold in containers ranging from 1 qt. to 55 gallons, you should maintain 2 separate "Storage and Disposal" Statements.
 - a. One set would be for containers 1 gallon or less: "Do not store on side. Avoid creasing or impacting of side walls. Store in dry place at a temperature no lower than 50°F or higher than 120°F. Do not reuse container. Discard in the trash."
 - b. The second set would represent containers greater than 1 gallon. The submitted label's "Storage/Disposal" instructions are adequate.

A stamped copy of the labeling accepted with conditions is enclosed. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed label before distributing or selling the product bearing the revised labeling.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This carpet sanitizing concentrate should be an integral part of any carpet maintenance system. Routine application will not only clean the carpets, but sanitize and deodorize for a cleaner, longer lasting carpet. It is a low foaming carpet shampoo formulated for use with extraction and carpet steam cleaning equipment. It contains "twin chain" quaternary ammonium compounds to reduce the growth of odor causing bacteria.

It is fortified with odor counteractants to neutralize malodors. Optimized for use on washable synthetic fibers, but not recommended for use on wool carpets. It effectively and economically lifts and removes greasy soil, resists resoiling and utilizes "built-in" defoamers for more productive use. It leaves no residue to promote resoiling and eliminates soil redeposition to vacuum pickup tanks.

TO CLEAN, SANITIZE AND DEODORIZE CARPETS.

STEAM EXTRACTION: Vacuum carpet thoroughly. Mix two (2) ounces of carpet sanitizing concentrate per gallon of water. Inject and extract as you would any other steam cleaning shampoo.

EXTRACTION: Vacuum carpet thoroughly. Mix two (2) ounces of carpet sanitizing concentrate per gallon of water. Prespray onto the carpet at a rate of 1/3 - 1/2 gallon per 100 ft. and extract as you would other extraction cleaning shampoos.

SPIN BONNET (BONNET BUFF) CLEANING: Vacuum carpet thoroughly. Mix four (4) ounces

of carpet sanitizing concentrate per gallon of water. Bonnet on carpet at rate of 200-300 sq. ft. per gallon.

BONNET CLEANING: Vacuum carpet thoroughly. Mix four (4) ounces of carpet sanitizing concentrate per gallon of water. Spray on carpet at a rate of 200-300 sq. ft. per gallon.

HEAVY DUTY SPIN BONNET (BONNET BUFF) CLEANING: Vacuum carpet thoroughly. Mix sixteen (16) ounces of carpet sanitizing concentrate per gallon of water. Spray on carpet at rate of 200-300 sq. ft. per gallon.

NOTE: For indoor use only.

NOTE: Test colorfastness of carpet before use. Apply diluted cleaner to a small concealed spot, then rub with clean white cloth. If color transfers to cloth or changes, a water base product should not be used.

NOTE: Not recommended for use on stain-resistant nylon carpets. Consult carpet manufacturer's warranty and maintenance instructions for proper use.

After cleaning, set carpet pile in one direction with a stiff brush (carpet pilator). Place aluminum foil under legs of furniture while carpet is drying. Over-wetting can cause shrinking of carpet. Manufacturer assumes no responsibility for over-wetting or misuse.
