DIRECTIONS FOR USE - SHAKE WELL. Remove droplets. To control bird lice, leave birds in cage, but remove all food, water and foodstuffs. Using quick spray strokes, spray directly on birds from a distance of 12 to 18 inches. Do not spray into the eyes or face of pet or cage. Mite control: remove birds plus food and water. Clean cage thoroughly in hot water and repeat at least once weekly. After cleaning, spray cage from 12 inches with 5 or 6 pump actions. Don't spray bird or cage more than twice weekly to continue control of lice and mites. Replace over-cage after use.

CAUTION - Irritant if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing of spray mist. May cause eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Do not spray into the eyes or face of bird. Do not use on birds under 6 weeks of age. Do not use near fish, turtles, or foodstuffs.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT - IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of the throat with a finger. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water.



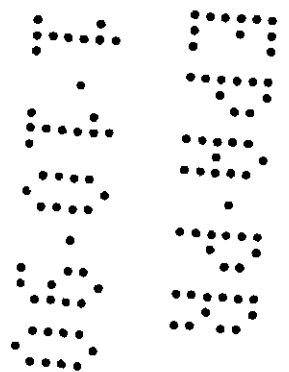
STORAGE - Store in a cool, dry place away from heat or open flame and inaccessible to children and pets.

Your Letter Dated January 4, 1989

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided you make the following label changes:

1. Delete petroleum oils from the Active Ingredients list and add it to Inert Ingredients.
2. Revise the paragraph "Foods should be removed or covered during . . ." to include the following statement:

After using this compound, equipment and utensils must be washed with an effective cleaning compound and thoroughly rinsed with potable water before operations are resumed.

Add this paragraph to the Precautionary Statements portion of the label.

3. Move "Do not remain in treated areas . . ." to the PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS portion of the label.
4. Delete the statement "Do not spray on turf or plants."

5. The Statement of Practical Treatment portion of the label should be placed under the signal word CAUTION and should read as follows:

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If Swallowed: Do not induce vomiting. Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately.

If Inhaled: Remove to fresh air.

If On Skin: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected area with soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. Wash contaminated clothing separately from other laundry.

If In Eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

Note To Physician: Contains petroleum distillate. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.

6. Add the following statement to the Environmental Hazards portion of the label:

Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

Submit five (5) copies of the revised labeling.
