

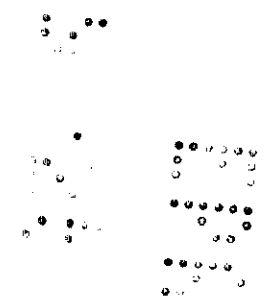

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling

FOR FOGGING:

Area to be treated should be closed and filled with a fine mist. Keep treated area closed for a minimum of 10 minutes. Open the area after ten minutes and remove the fallen insects. This space spray concentrate is ready for use in electric vaporizers

Do not remain in treated areas and ventilate the area after treatment is completed.

Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. May be used in kitchens, bakeries, restaurants, packing plants and similar areas. When using the product in these areas, apply only when the facility is not in operation.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE AS A HORSE FLY SPRAY & RUB

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SPACE SPRAY NO. 3 has been formulated for use on your horse and pony show stock. Do not use on food animals. The product may be sprayed or wiped onto the animal's coat and will also impart a bright sheen to the animal's coat. Apply regularly during fly season.

AS A SPRAY: Select a hand sprayer which will apply the product in a fine mist or fog. Use one to two ounces per animal per day. Also treat adjacent stable areas for more effective fly control. Do not wet the animal's skin. After application, brush the coat to give overall coverage. Make sure that legs and ankles are treated. For face area treat as a wipe on application.

TO WIPE ON: Rub the animal down and remove dirt. Pour a small amount (1 ounce) into a soft cloth and wipe on against the hair grain. Make sure to treat legs, belly, the neck and facial areas as well as the back line. Do not wet skin. After this application, brush the coat to bring out a bright sheen. Repeat as needed to kill and repel biting flies. During fly time best protection will be given by treating animals 3 to 4 times each week.

This product must not be used on horses intended for food use.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. **STORAGE:** If container is damaged, stop any leaks by repositioning the container or by patching or otherwise repairing the leaks. Take care to avoid contact with pesticide and wear protective gear. On cleanup of spilled liquids, wear protective equipment as required to prevent exposure. Clean up spilled areas with generous amounts of absorbent material, such as clay, diatomaceous earth, sand or sawdust.
