
# FOR GENERAL DISINFECTING AND CLEANING PURPOSES

40 parts of water to 1 part disinfectant. Never use boiling water, lukewarm water gives best results. This solution may be used to disinfect sickrooms and sickroom utensils, telephone mouthpieces, for deodorizing outdoor closets and garbage receptacles, and for all everyday disinfectant applications.

Floors: For scrubbing floors (or mopping,) use 40 parts water to 1 part disinfectant.

URINALS AND TOILET SEATS 4 oz. disinfectant to each gallon of water. Expel residual bowl water over the trap. Apply freely to surfaces to be disinfected and flush the drain pipes with the solution.
