The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted.

1. Delete the statement, "Contains Potash Soap and Isopropanol," from below the ingredient statement. Please note that your formulation does not contain a potassium source to form potash soap.

2. The letter "o" after the word sodium should be in lower case:

Sodium o-benzyl-p-chlorophenate

3. The word "oil" in Pine oil should be spelled with a small "o." You must be consistent.

The foregoing was in response to the June 8, 1988 amendment.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of the Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product is a disinfectant, cleaner and deodorizer for commercial and light industrial cleaning. For use on walls, floors and other inanimate hard, nonporous surfaces. Effective against *Salmonella choleraesuis*, *Staphylococcus aureus* and *Pseudomonas Aeruginosa* when diluted one part disinfectant to 40 parts water.

Use 16 oz. per 5 gallons of water. Pour the disinfectant into a clean bucket then add the water. Use warm water for best results. Apply with a mop, sponge or cloth.

All surfaces must be pre-cleaned prior to disinfecting. Thoroughly wet all surfaces. Treated surfaces must remain wet for 10 minutes. Rinse with fresh water. Fresh solution must be prepared daily or when the used solution becomes visibly dirty.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

STORAGE: If container is damaged, stop any leaks by repositioning the container or by patching or otherwise repairing the leaks. Take care to avoid contact with pesticide and wear protective gear. On cleanup of spilled liquids, wear protective equipment as required to prevent exposure. Clean up spilled areas with generous amounts of absorbent material, such as clay, diatomaceous earth, sand or sawdust. Sweep the contaminated absorbent on to a shovel and put the sweepings into a salvage drum. Dispose of the wastes as below. Place any leaking container into a similar drum or glass as below. Mark the container with name of product, ingredient statement, precautionary statements and signal word.

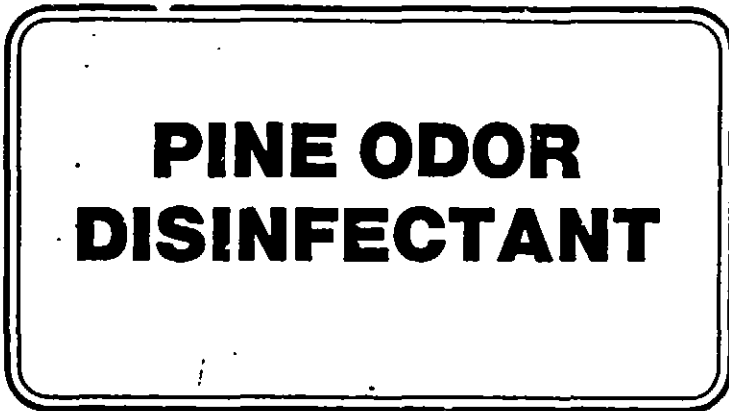

Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
